Shrivastava Award, researcher has to specify on the right top of the paper proposed to submit for the XVII AZRA International Conference at UAS, Raichur, on 12-14<sup>th</sup> February, 2020, that this paper is for poster presentation to compete for this award. Papers submitted for this award will be scrutinized by a panel of experts and will be declared and awarded on last day of the Conference.
- 5. For Prof. Damodar Satapathy Award, one best research paper published in J. Appl. Zool. Res. (2018 & 2019) will be judged by the jury and conferred during XVII AZRA Intern, Conference at UAS, Raichur.
- 6. For AZRA Fellowship Award, only qualified members should file their nominations and the list of the qualified AZRA members is circulated by General Secretary AZRA. Member, who fulfils this criteria, has to submit his/her bio-data along with brief research contributions (only 1 page), two passport size photographs and a DD for Rs. 1000/-.
- 7. For AZRA Honourary Fellowship Award nominations are proposed by AZRA-Executive Council.




